

## **Pre - hospital course**

The pre-hospital course aims to the improvement of care for trauma and non-trauma patients, promoting critical thinking and skill development. The course will be mainly scenario based simulation in Prehospital Trauma Life Support using realistic, full-body, computer interactive simulators and is aiming at the development of skills regarding life threatening injuries.

### **PARTICIPANTS**

The course is designed for 20 participants (Emergency Medicine physicians, paramedics, nurses, medical students)

### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

The course focuses on scenario-based training and consists of the following stations:

- Introduction lecture
- Scenario based skill stations
  - airway management
  - tension pneumothorax (decompression skills)
  - pelvic trauma- internal hemorrhage (diagnostic U/S)
  - use of I.O. devices

Duration of the course is from 9 am to 5 pm
